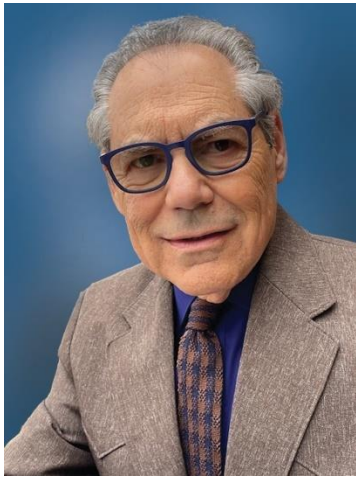


Robert W. Snyder JD MPH



Robert W. Snyder JD is an accomplished attorney, advisor and entrepreneur with expertise in successfully growing businesses through strategic capital development, asset acquisition and marketing.

He is a licensed litigation and tax attorney who operated a private tax practice in Beverly Hills, CA, where he worked with clients in the movie and entertainment industries before agreeing to serve Of Counsel to a specialty law firm.

Snyder currently practices and mentors in Arizona, where he utilizes his experience in private practice and business management, advising both clients and other attorneys on litigation issues related to U.S. and internationally-based businesses.

Snyder also built a successful career outside of the practice of law in the healthcare sector. He founded a company which focused on asset acquisition and the operation of outpatient surgery centers across the U.S. and grew the business to more than 30 facilities with annual revenues of more than \$100M. He successfully sold the company in 2005 to pursue other entrepreneurial interests.

He went on to serve as Executive Advisor and General Counsel to an international venture capital firm providing infrastructure support to technology, medical device and medical service startups and to an entertainment technology firm and app builder.

Snyder has served on the Board of Directors of multiple companies and on the Executive, Finance and Documents committees of large homeowner associations. He is a trial law consultant, an active mentor and involved community member who has run for political office. He served as a SCORE Certified Mentor in the Greater Phoenix MSA for three years, where he was also active in Outreach and CEO development initiatives. SCORE is a technical assistance resource partner to the U.S. Small Business Administration and a non-profit which is funded by Congress.

Snyder holds a Master's degree in Public Health Management from the Aristotle University School of Public Health. He is separately certified in NLP (neuro-linguistic programming) training as a Master Practitioner. He studied tax law at Boston University School of Taxation and was admitted to the U.S. Tax Court in 1981. His JD was earned at Suffolk University Law School in Boston. He later taught law at Aristotle University School of Law.
